The Alpaca Canada Futurity and Select Sale Steering Committee will make selections at their discretion based primarily on quality, but will also take into consideration age, colour, **reserve price** and pregnancy status in order to offer a balanced selection.

Male alpaca entries may be submitted, however only outstanding males will be considered.

Only **completed** entry forms containing the following will be considered by the committee:

- Photos showing left side, right side, front, rear, bite in profile and head of the alpaca (jpg format or hard copy)
- Catalogue ready photo (only the sale alpaca in the photo, standing sideways or 3/4, with a non-busy background). Please make sure that this photo is showing the alpaca the best possible way. Hard copy is preferred.
- A fist full of fibre from this year's shearing. fibre samples
- Copy of CLAA registration
- Copy of 2009 histogram
- Proof of BVDV PI negative status (for females with cria at side, proof of BVDV PI negative status for the cria will suffice)
- Completed catalogue comments (please double check for correct spelling as it will be uploaded on site and printed in catalogue as it is provided)
- Cheque of \$1000 (payable to Alpaca Canada Futurity & Select Sale)

Consignment Terms

1. All Alpacas will be sold according to the laws of the Province of Ontario.
2. All Alpacas **must** have CLAA registration certificates.
3. A selection committee will make selections for the sale from the consigned Alpacas. Sale selection criteria will be based on fibre quality, conformation, colour, age, pregnancy status and **reserve price**. The entry fee will be refunded for any alpaca not selected.
4. Veterinary inspection of all sale alpacas will take place at Orangeville on Friday, November 20, 2009, 1pm-3:30pm. Check in time is from 9am to 1pm.
5. Veterinary check will be for general health and for any CLAA Breed Standard congenital disqualifiers. (Please consult the CLAA Breed Standard). Alpacas failing the veterinary inspection will **not** have the entry fee refunded.
6. All sale entries must be stalled in the sale row area. There will be one sale animal per pen.
7. Entry fee is non refundable for any reason.
8. All Alpacas will be sold with a fertility guarantee and the guarantee that every effort will be made to satisfy the buyer, from suitable replacement, or as last resort money back.
9. The owner of any alpaca accepted into the sale agrees to hold Alpaca Canada harmless from damages in the event that unusual or unforeseen circumstances result in the change of location, change of time or date, or cancellation or similar modification of this sale.

Terms and Conditions

Hereinafter, the Alpaca Canada Futurity and Select Sale Steering Committee will be referred to as the Sale Committee.

1. It is clearly understood that Alpaca Canada is acting only as an intermediary between buyer and consignor and is not responsible for any failure by either party to live up to its obligations. Alpaca Canada assumes no responsibility, liability, obligation, duty, either singular or plural and make no warranties as to title, or quality including but not limited to health, blemishes, defects, soundness, or any other conditions of entry, and makes no other kind of warranty whatsoever.
2. Neither the Auctioneer, Alpaca Canada, nor any of their representatives make any representation or warranties whatsoever with respect to the sale alpacas. All representations contained herein are made by the seller only.
3. The laws of the Province of Ontario will govern the sale and all transactions between the Buyer and the Seller.
4. The highest bidder is to be the buyer and if any dispute arises between two or more bidders, the alpaca in dispute shall immediately be put up again for advance bids. If there is no advance, the alpaca shall go to the person whom the auctioneer recognized as having the last bid. The auctioneer's decision shall be final. The auctioneer reserves the right to reject any or all bids. Bidding will be carried out in Canadian Dollars.
5. All information listed in the "Consignment Form" and description for the sale catalogue is solely supplied by the seller. Alpaca Canada is not responsible for the accuracy and validity of said information.
6. At the completion of the Select Sale, the buyer shall sign the Agreement of Sale and Purchase. Title passes when a buyer signs the agreement at which time all risk and responsibility for the alpaca passes to the buyer.
7. All Alpacas will have been veterinary inspected. Insurance will be the responsibility of the buyer immediately upon signing of the sale and purchase agreement on the day of the Select Sale.
8. Payment is due at the completion of the sale either in full or as a down payment (as per sellers financing plan). Payment is to be by cash or cheque payable to seller. Payment must be submitted to Alpaca Canada's sale clerk immediately on completion of the Select Sale proceedings.
9. If any person shall purchase a lot and not pay for it as described above, the Auctioneer and/or the Seller shall have the right to resell the lot or, at their option, bring action for specific performance, in which event the buyer agrees to pay all costs of such suit and reasonable attorney's fees. In the event of resale, the defaulting Buyer agrees to pay all cost of resale plus price deficiency.
10. Every effort has been made to assure correctness of the catalogue, however Alpaca Canada is not responsible for errors or omissions. Any known corrections shall be announced at the sale.
11. Statements made from the Auctioneer's Box shall take precedence over any and all statements made in the catalogue.
12. Any person attending the auction does so at their own risk and no liability, duties, obligations, and/or responsibilities shall be imposed upon Alpaca Canada, Auctioneer or their representatives for any accident, injury, mishap, theft, damage, and/or any other harm regardless of the source of imposition.
13. The seller warrants that their alpaca is free from any encumbrances whatsoever.
14. Alpaca Canada at their discretion reserves the right to withdraw any alpaca from the sale without liability to anyone.
15. The seller will withhold all registration papers until all cheques clear the bank. At such time they, along with the transfer fees will be sent to the appropriate registries. Seller must pay all transfer fees.
16. It is the buyer's responsibility to have the purchased animal removed from the sale site by 11am following the day of the Select Sale.
17. Foreign buyers must contact the seller of sale animal of interest to understand export and quarantine requirements and arrangements prior to Select Sale.
18. Buyers planning to board their purchases after the Select Sale must make prior arrangements with seller or other parties of their choice.
