The 'Most Successful Exhibitor' ribbon was won by various craftspeople who submitted entries under the name of Canadian Comfort Alpacas, St. Ann's, Ontario. Under the new rules for 2008, "there is a limit of two exhibits per Exhibitor per class". Unfortunately, when entries were checked-in prior to the competition, numerous entry forms from individuals were listed as having been entered by Canadian Comfort Alpacas as opposed to the individual artisans who actually created the pieces and thus, Canadian Comfort Alpacas exceeded the two-exhibit limit in one class and were not scored. AC apologizes for the mix-up. Henceforth, all entries must be made in the name of the artisan who created the work, including complete address and contact information. There will be a separate box indicating who is responsible for 'picking up the article'.
